 - 5.1. A.R.S. § 48-954, A.R.S. § 42-17101, A.R.S. § 42-17102. As presented in the preceding Arizona Revised Statutes the District must establish a preliminary budget on or before the 3rd Monday in July, however the Trujillo Trail DWID was not fully formed in time to meet that requirement. A Draft Budget will be presented for possible discussion and action.
 - 5.2. The TTDWID has statutory authority to establish certain kinds of fees (see A.R.S. § 48-910 for specific information about the types of fees authorized). A hearing must be held prior to the approval of such fees and the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors must be notified of the hearing at least ten days in advance. The Board of Supervisors has the authority to be represented at the hearing and to advise the district's governing board (A.R.S. §48-910(C)).
- 6. **Public Official Overview**. Board of Directors discussion and training overview regarding Arizona Open Meeting Law, Arizona Public Records Law, and other legal requirements applicable to public officials.
- 7. **Call to the Public**. At this time any member of the public is allowed to address the Board of Directors on any issue within the jurisdiction of the TTDWID. Pursuant to the Arizona Open Meeting Law, at the conclusion of Call to the Public, individual members of the Board may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the Board, and may ask staff to review the matter, or may ask that the matter be placed on a future agenda.

 - 8.2. Future Agenda items. At this time, any member of the Board may request that an item be placed on a future Board Meeting agenda.
- 9. **Executive Session** (If required).
